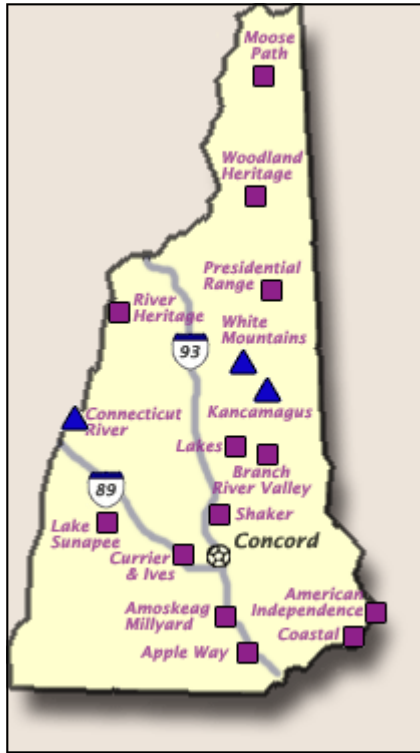

Connecticut River Byway Directions

New Hampshire Section

Section 1 - NH 63 and NH 12

Follow the Massachusetts border north along NH 63 for 21.6 miles to the intersection of NH 63, NH 12 N, and 12 E. From the intersection of 12 E and NH 12 N, go 5.7 miles to Walpole.

Section 2 - NH 123

Take US 5 back to NH 12 and cross the Connecticut River into New Hampshire. From the junction of NH 12 and NH 123 in Walpole go east 2.7 miles to the village of Cold River. From Cold River, drive 1.6 miles north to North Walpole.

Section 3 - NH 12 and NH 12A

Follow NH 12 for 13.5 miles to the intersection of NH 12 and NH 12A east. Take 12A for 26.9 miles from North Charlestown to Claremont Junction to West Claremont to the intersection of 12A and NH 103. Go straight ahead to Plainfield Village, through West Lebanon to the intersection with US 4.

Section 4 - US 4 and NH 10

From the intersection of 12A and US 4, drive 0.3 miles to the intersection of US 4 West and NH 10 North. Follow NH 10 North for 40.1 miles to the junction of NH 10 and NH 135.

Section 5 - NH 135 and US 3

Follow NH 135 for 46.6 miles past the junction with NH 302 until it intersects with US 3 and US 2 near Lancaster. Follow US 3 for 76.5 miles to the Canadian border.

Section 6 - US 3 and NH 145

From the Canadian border, turn around and drive south on US 3. Near Pittsburgh, US 3 and NH 145 intersect. Follow NH 145 for 13.1 miles until junction with US 3.

Kancamagus Byway Directions

The Kancamagus Scenic Byway follows Hwy 112 for 34.5 miles. It begins at the junction of I-93 and Hwy 112 in Lincoln (near the Pemigewasset River) and goes east until it ends in the city of Conway at the junction of Hwy 112 and Hwy 16.

Moose Path Byway Directions

The byway is located in the northern part of the state. It starts just south of the city of Berlin (in Gorham) on Route 16 and heads north, onto Route 26 and then Route 3, until it almost reaches Canada. The route ends in Pittsburg.

Presidential Range Byway Directions

The route begins in Littleton and follows NH 116 north to Whitefield.
From Whitefield, it follows US 3 north to Lancaster.
The byway then takes route 2 through Jefferson and then Randolph.
You get back onto NH 16 and go south through the heart of Pinkham Notch.
You may want to drive the Mount Washington Auto Road (fee charged).
The next step is to turn west on US 302 into the city of Bartlett.
The route then swings back towards Littleton.

River Heritage Byway Directions

Begins at US 3 in North Woodstock
Travels south along US 3 and over NH 175
Goes through Plymouth
Continues onto NH 25
Passes through Warren
Heads along NH 25C, toward NH 10
Goes on to Piedmont
Progresses through Haverhill

Alternative finish #1

Swing north onto US 302/NH 10 to visit the historic towns of Woodsville, Bath, Lisbon, and Franconia.

Alternative finish #2

Take a more direct route back to North Woodstock via NH 112.

Woodland Heritage Byway Directions

The loop begins in Lancaster and then continues north on US 3 north to Northumberland.
The route then goes East along Route 110 through Stark.
Then follow NH 110A and then a right onto Route 110B.
Then head Southbound on NH 16 through Milan, Berlin and Gorham.
Then travel on Route 2 westbound through Randolph and Jefferson.
The loop ends back in Lancaster

White Mountain Trail Byway Directions

Driving the Byway from Conway

Take State Hwy 16 north for 2.81 miles, then merge with US-302. Follow US-302 for 37.71 miles, going through North Conway and following it west at Glen. Continue west northwest on US-302 until you reach Twin Mountain, at which point, head west on US-3 for 10.23 miles. Take I-93 south for 7.5 miles, then take US-3 for 2.76 miles to North Woodstock.

Driving the Byway from North Woodstock

Take US-3 north for 2.76 miles, then take I-93 north for 7.5 miles. Then, head east on US-3 for 10.23 miles until you reach Twin Mountain, at which point head east southeast on US-302 for 37.71 miles. At Glen, follow it east through North Conway. Merge with State Hwy 16 and go south for 2.81 miles to Conway.

There is a spur that heads south from Bartlett, and it follows Bear Notch Road for 8.5 miles.
